



LAPATHON 2020

The Applecross Primary School P&C is once again holding its annual Lapathon as a major fundraiser for the year, with funds raised going towards our new fabulous outdoor classroom! This year it will take place on **Wednesday, 17th June**. Children are asked to collect sponsorship pledges on the form provided before the event. Please turn over for the sponsorship form.

The Lapathon will commence at 1.45pm, with all students encouraged to walk/jog (or a bit of both!) for one hour. Students in pre-primary, year 1 and year 2 will complete a 150m circuit, with students in year 3 and above completing a 250m circuit of the school oval. The number of laps students complete will be recorded during the event and the final total will be sent home. Students will then collect their donations. We would ask that donations are transferred electronically into the P&C's nominated account (details overleaf on the sponsorship form).

Kindergarten children will hold their very own Lapathon. Details of the date and time will be provided by their teacher.

Two class prizes will again be awarded this year;

1. The first class to collect and return all of their sponsorship forms and money.
2. The class that raises the most money.

The Lapathon has been designed to be a happy, healthy and fun way to raise money for our school. Fruit, that has been generously donated, will be available to the students throughout the event to give energy levels a boost. All money raised will be put straight back into the school to benefit all of our children.

Due to the current restrictions in place, spectators are unfortunately unable to watch the event from the school grounds. You can however watch from outside the school gates along Kintail Road, Sixth Avenue or Kishorn Road. Spectators will need to comply with the social distancing requirements in place at the time of the Lapathon. We greatly appreciate your assistance with this.
