As part of the Year 6 Civics and Citizenship program, Year 6 students from Rooms 15, 16 and 17 will attend incursions run by the Constitutional Centre as well as an excursion to Parliament House and the Constitutional Centre. These experiences will give students the opportunity to develop their understanding of the key values that underpin Australian democracy.

Our excursion to **Parliament House** and the **Constitutional Centre** is on **Tuesday 29 May**. The cost is \$13 and will be deducted from your child's upfront payment.

Students will depart school by bus at 8.45am and return to school by 3pm. As this is an early close day, students may arrive back at school after the siren. Throughout the day, students will participate in a guided tour of Parliament House where they will develop their knowledge and understanding of the history, role and functions of Parliament in Western Australia. They will also visit the Constitutional Centre where they will gain an awareness of our federal system of government, democracy and electoral education.

On the day, children need to bring a drink, recess and lunch in disposable containers. They will not require their school bags.
