The Applecross Primary School Board is integral to the good management and direction of our school. As a body it provides support and advice on general matters related to school routine and procedure as well as approving policy direction and strategic planning.

The Board consists of 10 members with 7 being Parent Representatives. Terms of the members are staggered. Three of our Parent Representative Board members will be coming to the end of their two year term at the end of 2024.

The process of selecting to fill these three positions commenced on 16 September this year when I called for expressions of interest from parents of children at Applecross Primary. Please note the following points concerning the election process:

- The online election will run from midday Monday 21 October to midnight Sunday 27 October 2024.
- Each registered (email) parent or carer with a current student/s attending our school is eligible to vote and will receive an email with a link to the online election. For obvious reasons, it is important that the election is a fair process and that each parent/carer who receives an email with a link to the voting eForm only votes once.
- You are required to nominate **THREE** of the FOUR candidates.
- Results of the election will be available as soon as the results have been collated and all mandated checks have been completed.
