Dear Parents,

As advised last year, we are trialling how we deal with incursions/excursions by changing from the upfront payment system to paying for individual incursions/excursions as they arise during the year. In order for our office staff to be able to deal with the volume of processing the permissions, payments and advice to teachers of student participation, we require forms and payment to be completed by the **deadline** as requested.

I am aware of the number of various incursions/excursions happening throughout the school recently and also the activities of the P&C requiring similar requests. We are trying to simplify our processes to make it easier for you to access permission forms and make payments for your child. Permission notes in the first instance are sent home via the classroom teacher, then uploaded to the calendar on the school website, and posted on the Skoolbag App. If you have missed a permission form please refer to the school calendar (instructions overleaf) to obtain a copy.

We have updated the eForms on the Skoolbag App to now include payment options. This is our preferred method of communicating with you and for receiving your permission and payment confirmation. We then download the eForm electronically and process payment as per your instructions. Direct deposit is our preferred method of receiving payment as this can be completed by you at your convenience prior to the event/deadline.

Charges for incursions/excursions are calculated by the total cost of the activity and anticipated student numbers attending the event. This is why often requests for payment are not in whole dollars. Providing cash change to students is always a challenge for the school as we don't operate with a float, and is dependent upon how many parents pay by this method. All monies that come into a school need to be financially accountable through our receipting system and are auditable. Therefore we are unable to accommodate parents who wish to donate change from a school payment for incursions/excursions eg 5c, 10c.












The App allows parents to advise the school if a child is absent, update contact details and, where possible, return the 'eForm' consent forms via your mobile device. The names of those students who will receive an Honour Certificate at Assembly are published on both the website and the Skoolbag App one week prior to the fortnightly Thursday morning Assembly.
